FAQs about 777 Marathon and Bravehearts

Q What is 777 Marathon?

A 777 Marathon (777) was created in 2013 as a unique way for individuals to raise money for and awareness of Bravehearts and the prevention of child sexual assault. 777 is an annual ultra-Marathon that sees participants travelling across seven states, running one leg in each state each day over seven days.

777 is unique in that it attracts not only marathon enthusiasts, but also regular people who are looking for an endurance challenge that supports an important cause.

In order to participate in 777 runners must fundraise for and support the cause of Bravehearts. The Marathon involves two categories of participants – **National Runners** and **State Runners**:

- National Runners are those participants who commit to the entire seven days and seven state legs and raise a minimum of \$10,000 each for Bravehearts.
- State Runners are those participants who choose to run one leg of the Marathon (usually the one in their home state). State Runners can choose to register for their state leg as an individual participant, or as part of a team. Individual runners raise a minimum of \$130 for Bravehearts and teams a minimum of \$360.

Since its inception 777 Marathon has raised over half a million dollars for the prevention of child sexual assault.

Q Who is Bravehearts?

A Bravehearts is Australia's leading child protection organisation working holistically to prevent child sexual assault.

Bravehearts EDUCATES, EMPOWERS and PROTECTS Australian children by way of nationally recognised school and early-learning programs, training, specialist counselling services, research and lobbying.

Bravehearts' Vision is to make Australia the safest place in the world to raise a child.

Q What will Bravehearts do with the funds raised for 777?

Funds raised go towards helping Bravehearts prevent child sexual assault via preventative education and training programs. Funds also go towards supporting survivors of child sexual assault (including children and their protective family members, and adult survivors) via Bravehearts' specialist counselling services.

Key campaign messages of 777 Marathon 2019

- ✓ 777Marathon is Australia's mightiest marathon, with 7 marathons run across 7 states over 7 consecutive days.
- ✓ 777 Marathon raises funds for the prevention of child sexual assault.
- ✓ Every two hours in Australia, a child is sexually harmed in some way. It could be a child in your life, or someone you know.
- ✓ All Australians must work together to protect kids from the crime of child sexual assault.
- ✓ Educating children about personal safety is key to preventing child sexual assault.
